

Extended Abstract Instructions

Your extended abstract can be 4 to 6 pages including figures, but must not exceed 6 pages. Please make sure your abstract is correct prior to submitting because it will not be edited for content or grammar, and you will not have a chance to review it before it's published. Extended abstracts will be accepted only through 31 March 2010.

Preparation

Abstracts must be in English.

The preferred typeface is 12 point Times or a similar serif font.

On page 1, authors' names should be listed first, aligned to the left margin, in the following format:

JOHN SMITH, Exploration Company, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, LARRY WHITE, Vendor Technology Company, Adelaide, SA, Australia, and ROBERT HOWARD, Exploration Company, Houston, Texas, USA

Add the paper title, in upper and lower case, prepositions in lower case and text aligned to the left margin in the following format:

Exploring New Opportunities in Deepwater Basins

Text of the abstract should be single-spaced and in one column.

Category headings should be aligned to the left.

Add a space between all paragraphs. Do not indent paragraphs.

Figures or images can be black and white or colour, and should be embedded within your Word document or at the end of the document.

Include control ID at the beginning of the title.

Your extended abstract must be a Word or .pdf document.
